

How to Clean Fabric



Cleaning codes for each fabric and vinyl are available on the back of the manufacturer's fabric card or on the manufacturer's website. Based on the variety of types of fabrics and finishes, Butler recommends viewing each fabric's specific cleaning instructions for the best results. The cleaning codes for fabrics are below:

Cleaning Codes:

| | |
|-----|--|
| BC | Bleach Cleanable - 1 parts bleach, 9 parts water = 10% bleach, 90% water solution. Do not clean / disinfect fabric for longer than 10 minutes using the 10% bleach solution. Always rinse promptly with clean water after applying the bleach solution. Failure to do so will void any and all warranties. |
| C | Crypton Cleaning - Crypton fabrics are available in various fiber types, and all Crypton fabrics can be cleaned with soap and water. For the best cleaning solution, use CRYPTON UPHOLSTERY CLEANER, available from many manufacturers. |
| S | Clean this fabric with pure solvents in a well-ventilated room. Cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service is recommended. |
| S-W | Clean this fabric with the foam only of a water based cleaning agent for water based soiling, or with a pure solvent in a well-ventilated room |
| X | Clean this fabric only by vacuuming or light brushing to prevent accumulation of dust or grime. |
| W | Clean this fabric with the foam only of a water- based cleaning agent to remove overall soil. |
