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Bud Bug Facts to Know



- Bed bugs hide in crevices such as mattress seams, furniture joints, baseboards, and even screw holes.
- They do not discriminate—anyone, regardless of living conditions, can experience an infestation.
- Bed bugs can survive up to 12 months without feeding and withstand temperatures from nearly freezing to 122° F.
- The incidence of bed bugs is three times higher in urban areas due to population density, mobility, and apartment living.
- Adult bed bugs are about the size of an apple seed, and their saliva acts as an anesthetic—making their bites difficult to notice.



Myth: Bed bugs are caused by poor hygiene.

Fact: Hygiene and cleanliness do not determine risk. Bed bugs can appear anywhere people live, regardless of social or economic status.

Steps for Prevention and Control

Inspect & Identify: If you suspect bed bugs, have a licensed professional confirm the presence—many insects look similar.

Prevention Tips: Avoid bringing in used furniture. Vacuum regularly and seal cracks in floors. Use light-colored bedding to spot bed bugs more easily. Keep a gap between furniture and walls. Choose furniture with smooth, sealed surfaces that reduce hiding spots. Use tight-fitting, bed bugresistant mattresses and encasements.

Call a Professional: Treatment requires a licensed Pest Management Professional (PMP). Complete eradication typically takes about three weeks, with ongoing inspections recommended.



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
